

# The Debaters Association of Victoria Debate Camp 2013

After a successful pilot program, the DAV is excited to announce its Debate Camp for 2013. The non-residential debating camp will run over three days and is for students in Years 10–12 with previous debating experience. It will include:

- Seminars dealing with debating theory and strategy (hard/soft lines, case construction, preparation for secret topics, etc.)
- Matter tutorials from DAV accredited trainers on recurring debating themes (economics, governance, law, politics, etc.)
- Rebuttal workshops
- Manner exercises and voice drills
- Two practice debates each day, with feedback from DAV adjudicators
- Daily quizzes on current affairs

Places are limited, so please register early to secure a place. A second camp will also run over the July holidays.

Maximum of 6 students per school. However please advise us if you have more students interested and we will contact you if spaces are available.
